



## 4 – How do I choose?

In the tasks below you are going to work with a language problem you have defined yourself. The problem must be defined as a choice between two or more structures and the bank of sentences illustrating the structures should be available. Characteristics of each structure in the bank should be listed and grouped according to what they refer to.

By the end of working on the tasks you will formulate the rules that help you choose between the structures and check if these rules work.

### Task 1

Put down the problem you are working on filling in the template below:

### Task 2

Work in groups. Use the template below to define the rules to distinguish between the structures from Task 1. You can define as many rules as you believe is necessary to make the choice.

If you worked on Part 3, the results of Task 4 could help you. In any case, check that the characteristics in your rule refer to one and the same thing (e.g., 'large' and 'small' both refer to 'size' – same, however 'heavy' and 'huge' refer to 'weight' and 'size' – different).
